

How to Score Club Points for Annual Awards

- Only financial members can score points. Members who have not renewed membership within two months after the end of the financial year will be unfinancial.
- Whether a fish is tagged or captured, a completed Boat Angler/Activity form is the only valid method of scoring points. All captured fish must be weighed on certified scales.

- Each member is limited to tagging three fish of any species (other than billfish) per day and capturing three of any one species (including billfish) per day for weighing. Edible fish must be gilled and gutted and 10% of the body weight will be added to attain live weight for points.
- GFAA rules only apply.
- Refer also to your annual GFAA Gamefishing journal.
- Club fishing boundaries shall be inside QGFA Zone 1, Jewel Reef, Lizard Island to the North and Otter Reef, Mission Beach to the south. Only fish caught within these boundaries will be eligible for club awards.

Outside QGFA Zone 1 – Champion Billfish Angler award will also be presented at the Club's Annual Awards night.

- To score points for captured fish the weight must equal or exceed line class (e.g. a fish captured on 10kg line must weigh no less than 10kg).
- Awards will be presented at the annual general meeting following the end of the financial year.
